The sessions your child attends still need to be paid for even if for any reason they do not attend. The only exception to this rule is if your child is admitted to hospital. Please give 1 months' notice in writing should your child leave this setting.

We follow Lanivet School term time dates and close during teacher training. We always open 1 week earlier than the funding begins- this allows a 2 week October Half Term.
